

Bernard Williams' paper "The Self and the Future"

-Presents thought experiments to challenge the intuition that physical continuity or psychological continuity (memories, beliefs, intentions) constitutes personal identity.

Challenges the idea that psychological continuity alone is sufficient for personal identity, suggesting that our intuitive responses to these scenarios indicate that bodily continuity also plays a crucial role.

QUESTIONS:

-What are the moral implications of theories of personal identity for responsibility, punishment, and reward?

-How does the concept of the soul or a non-phy
